**Post-meeting AOB**: Confirmation that the Yorkshire and Humber Public Service Network (YHPSN) will be hosted from 1st of April by Bradford Metropolitan District Council, and the name change originally planned for 1st of January has been aligned with the change of host. It will therefore be known as the Yorkshire and Humber Digital Partnership (YHPD) as of 1st of April.
